Sermon: Stormy Times:

Introducing the Via Negativa with a summary of the four paths of Creation centred Spirituality from

The four paths of creation spirituality tell us what matters. We are told in Path One that awe and delight matter; in Path Two that silence, darkness, suffering, and letting go matter; in Path Three that creativity and imagination matter; and in Path Four that justice and celebration, which add up to compassion, matter. When the four paths are understood in light of the new cosmic story, then a whole civilization can be born because, while the four paths tell us what matters, the new creation story tells us why it matters—because it has taken 13.8 billion years to bring all these experiences of delight and suffering, of birth and justice-making, to this point in history. The Four Paths also address the question, Where will God, where will the experience of the divine, be found in our time? Creation spirituality responds: The divine will be found in these places: In the Via Positiva. In the awe, wonder, and mystery of nature and of all beings, each of whom is a "word of God," a "mirror of God that glistens and glitters," as Hildegard of Bingen put it. This is Path One. In the Via Negativa. In darkness and nothingness, in silence and emptying, in letting go and letting be; and in the pain and suffering and grief that constitute an equally real part of our spiritual journey. This is Path Two. In the Via Creativa. In our generativity we co-create with God: in our imaginative output, we trust our images enough to birth them and ride them into existence. According to Eckhart, we actually birth God or the Christ by our creative work in the world. This is Path Three. In the Via Transformativa. In the relief of suffering, in the combatting of injustice, in the struggle for homeostasis, for balance in society and history, and in the celebration that happens when persons struggling for justice and trying to live in mutuality come together to praise and give thanks for the gifts of being and being together. This is Path Four. Which spirals back to Path One again.
