Sermon: New ways of seeing

In Our Image—God's First Creatures A story to help us see differently

"In the beginning, God created the heaven and the earth. And when the earth was almost done, God said, "Let Us make humans in Our image, after Our likeness." To whom was God speaking when God said this?

Who is "us"? Who else is included in the word "our"?

God created the light and the darkness

"And the waters and the land,

and the trees and the plants.

And the sun and the moon and the stars.

And the fish in the waters and the birds in the sky. And all the wild creatures upon the earth. And God saw that it was good. But something was missing. And God said, "Let Us make humans in Our image, after Our likeness...""

All the animals heard the words of God and they gathered together in the sunshine, among the trees and the plants and all that God had created. "Are You speaking to us?" they asked. And God said, "Yes. I am speaking to ALL that I have created. Man and woman shall be a part of nature, like each of you. And nature shall also be a part of them. Let Us give Our gifts to woman and to man, for in Our image will I make them."

The sun and the moon and the stars sparkled with excitement. The waters shimmered and the earth covered with anticipation.

The animals were especially excited to be involved in this important moment. The birth of humankind!

They each thought about what gift they would give so that they would always be connected to man and to woman.

"Make them brave," said the tiger.
"Make them gentle" said the lamb
'Make them loud' roared the lion.
'Make them quiet' hushed the Clam.
"Make them small" said the ant.
"Make them large" called the whale
